Census 2013 is upon us with forms due to be completed on the 5th of March. From the census information, the Department of Statistics is able to provide a profile of each iwi which among other things assists with tribal planning and the settlement of Waitangi Claims.

The problem we face as the confederated iwi of Mokai Patea is that only Ngati Hauiti is listed as an iwi in the census. No information is collected on Ngati Whitikaupeka, Ngati Tamakopiri or Ngai Te Ohuake and furthermore, these iwi are technically not recognised by government officials.

As part of the process of gaining recognition and information for each of our iwi we ask that tribal members complete the census (as appropriate to them) as in the photo attached to this document.
