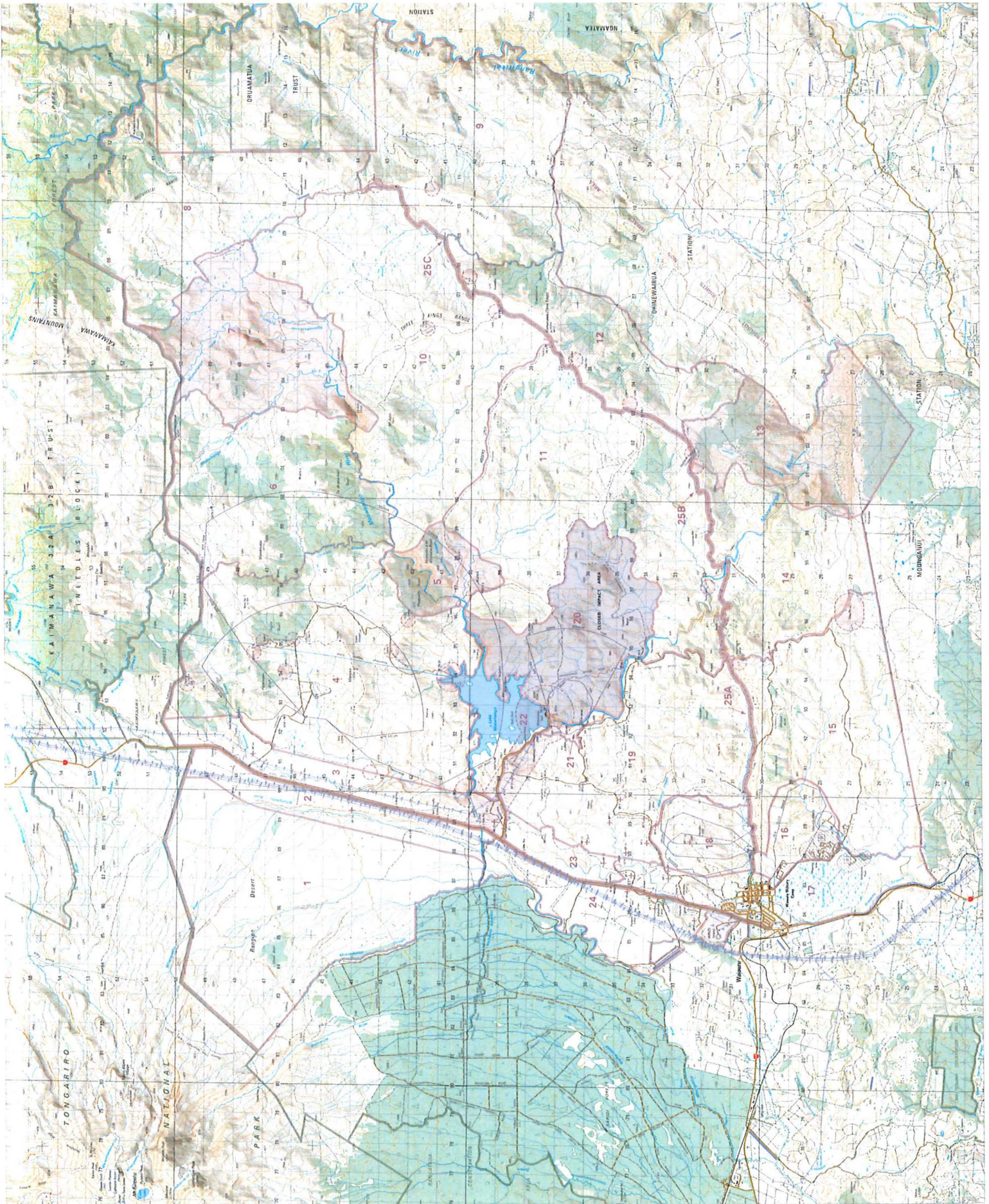

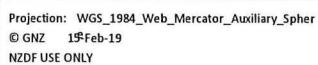



1. WO1 Hunter has undertaken some research on your behalf regarding the sub-tribe of this area. It would appear that this area is unique in that it does not have a substantiated sub-tribe.
2. Waiouru is part of the principle tribe of Ngati Tuwharetoa which extends from north of Taupo to Bulls. The other principle tribe is Atihaunui-A-Paparangi of the Wanganui district. Its eastern boundary is at the western bank of the Whangaehu River. Both claim ancestral rights to the area, but cannot pinpoint a sub-tribe.
3. It would be appropriate to say that Waiouru is part of Ngati Tuwharetoa.
