A candidate must:

- be recorded on the Members Register as an Adult Registered Member of Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whitikaupeka
- ✓ be recorded on the Members Register as affiliating to the iwi rūnanga hapū you wish to stand for
- \checkmark be 20 years of age or older at the date of the election (Thursday 30 November 2023)
- have one (1) Adult Registered Member of Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whitikaupeka nominate you, who also affiliates to the Iwi Rūnanga hapū that you are standing for

Nominations received after this date and time will <u>not</u> be accepted.

- Every candidate must be nominated by one (1) person who is 18 years or older and registered on the Mökai Pātea Members Register as being eligible to vote in the iwi rūnanga hapū for which the candidate is seeking election.
- 3 A candidate may not nominate themself for office.
- 4 Each nomination should be accompanied with a candidate profile statement (attached), and a current passport-size photo. Candidates should be aware that this information will be made publicly available for voting purposes.

Photos should preferably be in colour. If supplied in electronic format, it should be provided by email in a jpg format. Hardcopy photos will be accepted, and will be scanned at 300dpi by the Returning Officer. (NB: hardcopies of photos will not be returned to the candidate).

- If only two (2) valid nominations are received for a particular Hapū of Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whitikaupeka Iwi, then those two (2) candidates will be declared elected unopposed. If three (3) or more valid nominations are received for a particular Hapū of Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whitikaupeka Iwi, an election will be conducted by a postal ballot of persons registered to vote for that Hapū.
- 6 The candidate must sign the form of nomination to show their consent to the nomination. Failure to do so will make the nomination invalid
- 7 The candidate must <u>not</u> be ineligible to stand for election for any of the reasons outlined in clause 6, schedule 1 of the Mōkai Pātea Waitangi Claims Trust Deed of Trust (and as outlined below):

Mōkai Pātea Waitangi Claims Trust Deed of Trust Schedule 1: Election and Removal of Rūnanga Delegates Clause 6: Termination of office

- 6.1 A Rūnanga Delegate will cease to hold their position if he or she:
 - is censured under this Deed for acting in a manner that brings or is likely to bring into disrepute the Mōkai Pātea Waitangi Claims Trust, or the Iwi Rūnanga for which the Rūnanga Delegate has been elected;
 - retires from office by giving written notice to the lwi Rūnanga;
 - c. refuses to act;
 - d. is absent without leave from 3 consecutive ordinary meetings of the lwi Rūnanga, without reasonable excuse;
 - e. becomes physically or mentally incapacitated to the extent that in the opinion of the other Rūnanga Delegates, expressed in a resolution, he or she is unable to perform the duties of a Rūnanga Delegate;
 - f. ceases to fulfil the eligibility requirements for election;
 - g. becomes bankrupt;
 - h. completes his or her term without being re-appointed; or
 - i. dies.
